The Airport Carbon Accreditation (ACA) program helps airports progress through five levels of sustainability, from carbon footprint measurement (Level 1) to Net Zero (Level 5). Each level includes verified milestones such as emissions reduction and carbon neutrality. Third-party verification is required at application, every 2–3 years, and when advancing levels, including proof of Scope 1 and 2 emissions reductions from Level 2 onward.
