What is SAF and SAF Programs?

Sustainable Aviation Fuel (SAF) is a renewable fuel derived from sustainable resources, reducing greenhouse gas emissions compared to traditional kerosene. SAF mirrors the properties of conventional jet fuel, making it a viable substitute for fossil-based fuels. Airlines are adopting SAF Programs to allow corporate customers to purchase SAF or SAF Certificates (SAFcs) to offset Scope 3 emissions. These programs can sell credits at a premium or at cost, without profit claims.

What is SAF Program Assurance (SPA)?

SAF Program Assurance (SPA) is an audit process by Normec Verifavia to verify the legitimacy and compliance of an airline's SAF Program. SPA ensures SAF credits meet sustainability standards, confirming the integrity of the SAF Certificates issued and preventing double-counting.

SPA Audit Process

Step	Description
Documentation Review	Verifies SAF invoices for Scope 3 eligibility.
Personnel Interviews	Assesses SAF value chain procedures.
Audit & Analysis	Evaluates emissions reduction methods.
Accounting Review	Reviews SAF inventory or registry.
Eligibility Evaluation	Ensures compliance with SAF procurement.
Integrity Verification	Confirms SAF Certificate traceability.
